Please be reminded that costume payments are due in 2 installments; 1/2 payment is due on December 1st, and 1/2 is due on January 31st. Payment must be made in full no later than January 31st. Late payments will incur a \$10.00 late fee.

Costumes are ordered over the Christmas/New Year break and will not be ordered for any student whose payments, including tuition, are not up to date. All students are encouraged to participate in our annual performance. The performances are a very exciting time for the children; a culmination of their year's hard work and a time for their parents & families to enjoy watching them perform on stage! Performing encourages a wonderful sense of accomplishment and self pride, as well as developing a joy for performing. If for any reason however, your child is unable to participate in our year end performance, written notification is required.
