Dancers will be responsible for all rehearsals and a costuming/rehearsal fee, if accepted. Please keep in mind that this is a commitment for the dancers as well as for the parent(s)... but it is also a wonderful, fun and memorable experience that will be treasured for a lifetime! Back-To-Dance



- Don't forget to bring your smiles to dance class!
- Please remember to label your child's dance attire with their name so that we may avoid unnecessary shoe confusion and mix-ups! (dance shoes, skirts, sweaters, bags, etc.)
- Please be prompt and ready for class so that we may keep to the schedule as closely as possible. Children are apt to be more comfortable when on time, entering the class together as a group.
- All students are expected to be properly attired for dance class by October 1st, as outlined in your brochures.
- Please do not bring anything of value to class, (jewelry, etc.) as we cannot be responsible for lost items.
- Gum, food & drinks (other than water) are not permitted in the classrooms. Children may bring water bottles.
- If your child is going to be absent, a call to the studio is appreciated, (make-up classes are available). If you are running late to pick up your child, a call is also appreciated, so that we may avoid unnecessary panic and upset.
- The lobby is for everyone to enjoy... please, let's remember to pick up after ourselves and our children. Please don't leave half eaten food, coffee cups, soda, etc... let's not invite bugs!
- "FOOTNOTES" newsletters go out monthly. They will also be available on our website, www.danceworkshopofhanover.com. Please make it a "pointe" to read your Footnotes each month so that you won't be missing any important information.
- Please take a moment to read over your brochure if you have not yet done so. Keeping your brochure accessible will allow you to refer to it as needed throughout the year. Students and families are responsible for being aware of school policies as outlined in your brochures; your cooperation in observing the school policies is appreciated.

Tuition and Costumes



Please Note: tuition is due on the 1st class of each month for 10 months, September-June; May & June tuition must be paid together at the 1st class in May. Creative Movement tuition is due on the 1st class for 9 months, September-May with April & May payable together in April. Payments made after the 15th of the month are late and must include the \$10.00 late fee. Holidays, school breaks and a class cancellation (for snow, etc) have been calculated into the yearly total payment.

Tuition may be put into the mailbox in the lobby or mailed in to the studio (keeping in mind that it must be received by the 15th).

Please do not place cash in the mailbox, but rather make cash payments directly to Jenna in the office so that you may be given a receipt (morning classes, please give cash payments to the teacher). Why not include DWH when doing your online banking and avoid late payment & additional fees! We will also be taking credit card payments this year! MasterCard & Visa payments may be made on a monthly basis. Please see additional information passed out in a separate correspondence. If you are unsure of your tuition amount, please see the information posted in the lobby.

Please note - New for Costume Fees: Costume fees may be paid in 2 installments; ½ payment due on December 1st, 2011, and ½ due on January 31st, 2012 (with the exception of Creative Movement students). Payments not received in full by Jan. 31st, will result in a \$10.00 late fee. Please refer to your brochures for additional information.
