All students are to have hair secured back in a bun, no exceptions.

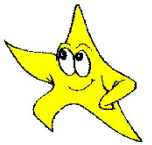
Jazz Class: leotard & tights. Older students may wear black jazz

including tuition, were up to date. Full payment may be made
by January 31st for the next order. After January 31st, there will
be a \$10.00 late fee assessed as well as a possible shipping fee
incurred. Again, please keep in mind that tuition payments must

Timely Tuition Payments

Please remember to make your tuition payments in a timely manner. Payments made after the 15th of the month are late and must include the \$10.00 late fee. If not included, the late fee will be applied toward your account balance. Please note: the yearly tuition has been calculated to include one class cancellation per year. If your child's class is canceled due to inclement weather or snow, there is no change to your monthly payment. If there is by chance a second class cancellation, there will then be a make-up class scheduled.
